My greetings to you in the love of our Lord Jesus Christ!

I would like to share with you about the blessing we got! “And we know that God causes all



things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to {His} purpose” (Rom. 8:28).

You and we have been praying to God about the Bible camp for the children for about a year. And God answered our prayers!

On June, 26 after the Sunday service we left for the island with the children; it was the island where our tent camp was located. But first I would like to tell you the prehistory of it...

Our team planned to do the camp for 30-35 children as the year before we had had about 30 kids there. Many parents were nervous about letting their kids go to the camp but through the DVD we recorded last summer the Lord did a great work in the parents' hearts.

So by June, 25 we already had 40 kids on the list! And I was getting more and more phone calls with one question: “Could you please also take my son/daughter to your camp?” So by the day the camp started we already had 50 children!!!

The time we spent with the children on the island ran very quickly!!! We played, we sang, we participated in different competitions! But the most important thing in all those activities was that they could learn more and more about Jesus Christ.

Many children helped the team leaders do the Bible study lessons as they already knew many Bible stories. But there were also many kids who knew completely nothing about God.

Actually before the beginning of the camp shift we had some leaders' meetings where we spoke about one of the main goals of our work there. It was to teach the children to pray! And our goal was reached!!! Before meals, before and after all the games, so DURING THE WHOLE CAMP SHIFT the children were praising God in prayers!!!

On the first day of our staying in the camp the rainy weather began. Nobody was sad! God was warming the hearts!!!



It was raining during all the camp days. Many of the camp leaders asked themselves a question, "Why is it so? We have been praying for fine sunny weather and God is sending rains to us!" But through the kids God was strengthening the adults.

Since the second camp day every kid raised his/her hand saying, "I would also like to pray!" On the fourth day we made a decision to bring the children home. All their things were wet and we had nowhere to dry them. It was morning. The cooks made a special breakfast for them and after breakfast without any invitation all the kids gathered together to pray and to sing some Christian songs.

I began this letter with the words from Rom. 8:28 "And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to {His} purpose"... After we had brought the children to their places all the staff was upset I think. We had only four days of camp instead of the seven planned. But the words "all things to work together for good" sounded from the heaven. When we came home we had an unexpected phone call from the city of Tula. They asked us to come there with our worship team. They turned out to have an evangelizing campaign among the Gypsies from June, 29 to July, 2. They said there were very many people who came to the events. So we went there and joined them praising God! Our brothers in Christ from the Ukraine joined us. We all together did this big service. So it was on purpose that God sent us rains during all the three camp days. During those days all the children became friends, they learnt to help one another in need and all of them learnt to pray speaking to God! And our team managed to glorify His Great Name in Tula! Praise Jesus!!!

Now we are in touch with many children. In August we plan to have 2-3 outdoors outreach events in the areas where the children who were in the camp are living.

Thanks a lot for your prayer and financial support! Together with you we are serving to Jesus Christ!
