Please, have a look at these pictures! Try to find any difference between an orphan and a child who has parents... It's almost never possible! But inside these children are very different. A child who does not see any parents' love and care has some inner changes that negatively influence his personality and, as a result, his future. The goal of the church is to change the way of the life prepare for them, to open to them the world of knowledge of Christ, to give them confidence in themselves and in their present and future using God's love as the key to it. So this is what our Christian orphans ministry team "Alone no More" is doing!

This summer was rich of outreach events for these children. Actually we have been out of the city since the middle of June having canoe trips, camps and walking tours.

We managed to organize a canoe trip for 25 people (some of them were orphans). While boating along the



rivers of the Kursk region, in our everyday fellowship we focused ourselves on the cognition of God's will, on studying the Scriptures and also studied in detail the lives of some biblical personages who became examples for the Christians of our days to follow.



16 orphans from the Mokva orphanage participated in the Program of the tent camp named "The Meeting



Island". The close fellowship with the Christian tutors gave them an opportunity to look into themselves very deeply to realize the necessity of the Savior. During the seven days of the camp shift the children touched Christ very closely and we have a strong hope that our spiritual fellowship will continue in the «Flight School of

Life» the Project that we are doing in this orphanage.





70 orphans from the Central orphanage participated in "The Sea Voyage to the Promised Land" Program that we did in the tent camp on our "Island of Salvation". During this camp shift we were very strictly checked by the city authorities. By God's mercy all went well and we were even offered to make the shift several days longer. In such situations we always want to exclaim, "'Great and marvelous are your deeds, Lord God Almighty!" (Rev. 15:3). We have another victory won by us with



God: this study year we will be doing the Flight School of Life program in the orphanage building! Praise the Lord!



We continue doing the orphanage graduates ministry called the Harbor of Kursk Project. Now there are 4 young men in the Project. They are learning to earn their living, to take care of the others and also studying the basis of the Christian faith. Three more orphanage graduates are dreaming of becoming the participants of the project, but we cannot take them there until one more room for living is ready there.

My wife and me decided to give them a room in our house as they do not have where to live till September. We are praying for God to take care of them in the future. The main goal of the "Training Farm" Project is launching chicken eggs production. Little by little we are moving to the start of this Project. This is our main prayer need in this



ministry. Today we are happy owners of a young horse and two sheep, but they bring no income.

One of the old residents of the Harbor of Kursk Project is Slava. This year he is finishing his studies in the lyceum. During the years of being in the Project he turned from a shy diffident guy into a mature young man who can earn his living and protect himself. He has a driving license, a car and the profession



of a metalworker. Slava enjoys the authority with the guys the Project participants. He is very helpful in the discipline and order issues. I am praying for his Christian beliefs to become deep, conscious; forming and guiding the main spheres of his life. He accepts Christ; he sees His care in his life but still does not trust Him completely the way it should be. Though the lack of trust is a usual problem typical of orphans, but still I want to believe that some day from the bottom of his heart Slava will say to the Lord, "You are my Heavenly father!"



This year we managed to spread our ministry to Jesus Christ in three orphanages of Kursk and Kursk region. 53 teens were the official participants of the Flight School of Life and finished this course, and 30 more teens were present there as “listeners”. The most popular were the lessons where we were studying the parables of Jesus



Christ, maybe because they deal with the some questions about life, questions that everyone asks himself. Besides that we studied the Gospel of John and the course of gaining some “life skills” including conflictology, relationship between girls and boys, time management, the family budget forming, communication with people of the same age and with employers and behavior in crisis situations. We also had the course of trainings helping to form the positive attitude towards oneself, toward other people and towards labor.

The best evaluation of our work became the statuses

presented by our pupils in the networks, such as:

“Remember about God when you are fine and He will remember about you when you are bad”, “It is never late to say “Forgive me” to God”, “ Don’t forget about those who are praying for you at nights”, “Start praising God for what you have and He will give you what you lack”, “Ony can fully devote himself to the others and they will not appreciate it, but God will, and the heaven will applaud, and that is the main thing”. As long as these children openly share with the whole world how much they value their relationship with God, it means the Holy Spirit is touching their hearts and our work is not in vain!!! That is why I am looking at the future with joy, prayer and hope and am dreaming of our meetings in the Flight School of Life to continue next study year! Thanks a lot for your prayers, your support and your care about the lives of hundreds of orphans.
