



Dear friend!

I am grateful to my Lord Jesus Christ for you and for the work you are doing for my Roma people in His glory! We were praying for the summer camp for children and God

made is possible!!! Praise Christ!



We planned to have our camp from 27th June through 4th July.

When our camp leaders and the staff were going to come to the place (it was evening 26th) it was raining cats and dogs. There is only a dirt road there. Thanks to the Lord we managed to get to the camp place. When we got up in the morning, the weather did not change for the better but got even worse. And the mood of many of us was even gloomier than the weather.



Many friends, many brothers and sisters in Christ called us there and said the sad news: the forecast for the week was bad. They expected heavy showers and low temperatures. At breakfast we were discussing the problem if it was worth to bring the children there for them to stay under such conditions? We decided to postpone the beginning of the camp for one day. We called all the children; but as for the kids from Belgorod region, they were already on the way to the camp. That day many people were praying for the camp, for the weather and for the children especially.

When the children from Belgorod region arrived, the things began changing for the better: there appeared smiles on the faces of the staff, there were more strong prayers to God and there sounded many songs glorifying our Heavenly Father. We had a wonderful fellowship; we joked and laughed and brought the wet things out of the tents to dry them. In such a gloomy weather the Lord warmed our hearts with the warmth of the Holy Spirit!!!



Next morning God by His grace made a miracle: the sky was

clear, the sun was shining and the birds were singing (they were of course singing also in gloomy weather, but we were too sad to pay attention to it). All the children arrived and we started our blessed camp! Time with these "angels" flew very quickly!

The common thread of all the events and activities was the following: "The life of everyone is in God's hands".

The age of the children and teens was from 6 through 18. God's love made them all

close to one another! During the camp days all the children, the teens and the staff became like one family.

I would like to share with you about our camp night watchman, Nickolay. He is a young man. He asked us to allow him to be the night watchman in our camp. After two or three days, after having seen how tense the ministry of the leaders was, he offered his help there. He was instructed



about all the rules and duties and began working as a leader's assistant: he helped in delivering the Bible study lessons, he helped in crafts making and in games; he was also very active taking part in all the camp events. But he had one problem: he had lost his relationship with the Lord and could not bring it back. Every time when we were talking with him about it he was very close to repentance, but he needed just one more step to make... He was missing just that one step.

In the camp among the ministers there was our dear brother in Christ Alan by name. He was not just present there; he was like a sunray for all of us: he was able to see God's guidance in everything! Some of the children were in such a camp for the first time; some of them saw Gypsy Christians for the first time in their life.

When the camp shift was over nobody felt like leaving and saying goodbye, especially the ones for whom the camp was done, that is the children and teens. But "To every [thing there is] a season..." Many of them said they would do their utmost to come to this wonderful "Camp Planet" next year again! They also promised that during this year they would often meet with one another for fellowship.



On Sunday, after all the children and teens had left, there was a blessed church service! Many of the congregation renewed their repentance before the Lord; there also stepped forward three boys from the camp.

When the whole church was in one spirit glorifying the Creator my friend and my brother Nickolay was sitting in the back row in tears pouring out his heart to the Lord. And again he was missing only one step for repentance, the Satan holding him tight. But with His death on the Cross Jesus

Christ broke the evil and the darkness!!! The Lord emboldened one of the brothers to come up to Nickolay, to take him by his hand and to bring him out before the people. Hallelujah!!! Our brother Nickolay was kneeled before his Savior!

In this man's life, like in the life of many of us, there can be many difficult moments; not all is easy the way we wished it to be. But we should always remember that we are all in God's hands, that He will abandon no one and that He loves all of us! He just allows some hard things to happen for us to become stronger, for us not to enter into temptation of this world of sin and lie and for us to always be in close relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ!!!
