We came to the place where we were received with open arms! There we met some young Christians from Byelorussia: they were travelling around the Tambov region sharing the Gospel. We were present at the baptism: a Gypsy man Ilya by name was baptized after having made a covenant with the LORD God. We had a great fellowship: many Gypsies were present there.

After baptism all the people went to the church and went to the service there. Young

brothers and sisters from Byelorussia were staying with the kids doing a Children's Program with them and we had a fellowship in Stepan's family. Stepan is the father of a big family of believers. They are all very friendly and hospitable; they serve the Lord and live by faith in Jesus Christ. We also met with an elderly Gypsy man Nickolay (he had accepted Jesus 17 years before). Praise the Lord for His goodness!

After coming back home we went on a short visit to our brothers and sisters in Christ to the settlement of Kirov. Now there is a rather small church there; but in the past it was the birthplace of the Baptist community of the Kursk region. We joined the church family and worshiped our Lord Jesus Christ together!!!

At the service we met brother Anatoly and his wife. They are just very nice people! They invited us to come to one of the services of the Prochorovka church, Belgorod region.

So, a week later our group went there. The church is rather small; in the congregation there are mostly elderly men and women. We participated in the service worshipping our Lord!

Dear friends! In remote places of the Kursk region we have one and the same picture: the number of believers is decreasing and most of the churches lack ministers.

But anyway, God's work is still going on and will go on by our prayers!!! And there will come the day when we all will gather near God's throne and will glorify Him through Jesus Christ as one big family!!!
