This crescent darkness impacts all the aspects of social life, and the conditions of sharing the Gospel with orphans is one of them. Praise Jesus for His glory and our thankfulness to the work of the Holy Spirit, for the opportunities for our ministry and for the hearts of the Christians dedicated to this ministry!

Thanks to your prayers we are doing the Flight School of Life Project in **three orphanages** of Kursk and Kursk region. Every week 53 high school age orphans have meetings, and we are helping them learn to see the world through the lens of the Scriptures. All of their personal, social and just everyday life

questions cannot stay without answers any longer since God gives all the answers. Their questions are wise, simple and practical and they gladly accept Biblical truths, learn to apply them in everyday life and to share them with their friends. This

Project also includes some extra food and some excursions and events for them: they love events which are widening their horizon! Unfortunately, according to some new government regulations, we don't have the right

to share any personal information about these

children anymore; neither send you their pictures. But if necessary we can share with

you about this ministry in further detail in a separate mail.













Sure we cannot, we just don't have any moral right to part with the ones who have already come through our Flight School of Life and who are adults now. They are still in need of spiritual support and wise advice. That's why we sometimes visit them, no matter where they live and study, helping they to restore their lives. We are always near since it is the Lord's calling. This month we visited the Flight School of Life grads, who are studying in the settlement of Svoboda, Kursk region. We brought



some gifts and some food to Kristina. Peter, Nikita and Ivan. We are grateful to God that none of the orphans who came through our Flight School of Life has taken the path of retrogression and criminality. More than 300 of our School grads are studying, working, have families, raising children and help those in need! And usually orphans are often considered to be troubled and

asocial ones! This is the real fruit of the work of the Holy Spirit in them.





For some of the orphanage grads The Harbor of Kursk Project is the next step after the Flight School of Life. Now we have an opportunity to



pay for the place for food and living and to give a job to three girls, who are orphanage grads. Their names are Dasha, Lyuda and Svetlana. One of them is mentally disabled but it does not prevent her from working and attending church with great joy! Several Christian women are their mentors. They help the girls adapt to life and live according to the biblical truths.





In the Training Farm Project there participate two orphans (a husband and a wife). They are young people with some mental disability. Their names are Lena and Sergey. They cannot work in a regular place and our task is to teach them make their living with their own hands. Now they have some chickens and can sell eggs. They are growing some rabbits for selling meat and dream of having a goat since goat milk can be well sold. In the future we are planning to produce cheese (when we have our own milk production) and to make bread in a mini-bakery. During this year there were seven young boys who asked to let them participate in the Training Farm Project, but after long

prayers we decided to invest our finances in the development of the training and technical basis of the farm than to invite there new participants. Only after the whole production process starts we will be able to have the farm functioning under self-sustainment and then we will be able to afford 6-8 people living there. But already today we understand that the Project is in demand by many orphans.





In October our team had a three days seminar for those who minister for children, for the families with adopted children, for single mothers and for the families with mentally disabled children. Our colleagues from Saint-Petersburg helped us with it. The topic of the seminar was "Upbringing Through Relationships". It's a

very important and popular topic. Melinda, an American teacher working with children, delivered this seminar. She managed to inspire the listeners and to

teach them some principles of the work with the at-risk children orphans included. This important information based on the modern science achievements will be very helpful for

us in "evoking a response" from avoidant orphans, in building relationships with them and in sharing the Gospel with them on a deep level, that is "from heart to heart".


